### Type and duration

Remunerated twelve-month traineeship, the first three months of which constitute a trial period

### Grant, benefits and insurance

• Maintenance grant: € 1,315 per month (from January 2018) • Travel expenses: one return trip reimbursed • Health insurance: obligatory (at own initiative, or through the EUI)
